Program Extensions

Lunch Bunch 11:45AM/Noon—1:30pm Available M—Th

This program is an extension of the children's day, allowing them to continue to explore, play and be with friends. Children bring a lunch from home and are supervised by staff members. Buy a 4-punch card for \$44 and then just sign up on the days your child will stay.

Preschool Classes

Curious 2's

Curious Two's is a terrific start to your child's preschool experience. The program will develop your child's sense of **curiosity**. The children enjoy interactive play, stories, action songs, creative art, and finger plays, within a safe and nurturing setting. Learning basic shapes, colors, matching, and counting brings a sense of accomplishment and a positive "I can do it" outlook. Social skills, making friends and sharing are all a part of the learning each day. Special events are included throughout the year!

Seeker 3's

This class offers a welcoming and safe environment for the young **seeker** to enjoy the wonder of discovery. The format includes circle time, stories, rhymes, games, puzzles and dramatic play, with the freedom to explore at their own pace and style. Beginning concepts of numbers, letters, and an introduction to science and nature make each day exciting. Plenty of art, gym and snack time are all part of the fun. Social skills and friendships grow as the children work together to develop a variety of age appropriate behaviors. As their confidence grows, so does their competence, giving them an edge for academic success.

Christian education is part of our total program. We bring the children together for regular chapel times to sing and hear stories from our Pastors and special guest speakers. Parents are welcome to attend these events. In the classrooms, the themes, stories, learning activities and discipline are wrapped around biblical principles.

Explorer 4's

Our Fours will be exposed to many opportunities for creative self-expression as they **explore** the planned activities within the classroom learning centers. Building upon what they've learned in the Three's, the children are encouraged to develop their fine motor, listening, early literacy, and school-readiness skills. The program includes a balance of age-related themes, identifying and writing letters, pre-academic math, science exploration and more. Together with friends, they enjoy a circle time of interactive stories, music, movement, and sharing, all while gaining new skills and preparing them for the next step in their school experience.

Voyager 4/5's

Students are engaged in a daily fun-filled educational **voyage** of adventure. They will refine and enhance their foundational skills while adding new ones. Classroom activities are designed to promote early literacy, letter recognition and writing, math, natural sciences, and social skills. While participating in creative art projects, cooking, show & tell, and inside/outside play, the children gain self confidence through graduated successes. Students are encouraged to make choices based on their growing interests and abilities as these topics are explored in greater depth. All of this is designed to ready the child for Kindergarten.

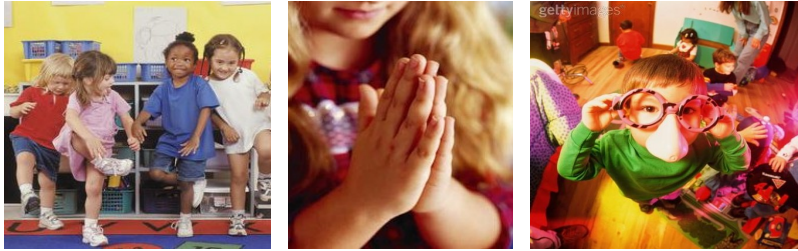
